## For which student awards should I apply?

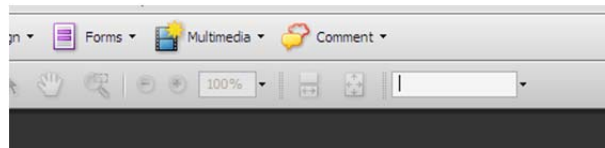
To find the student awards for which you are eligible to apply, you can easily search the SIAST Apprenticeship Student Awards Guide 2011 2012.

1. Go to [www.gosiast.com/scholarships](http://www.gosiast.com/scholarships).
2. Open the guide you want by clicking on the name of the Guide you would like to search.
3. You can read through the student award listings and make a list of the awards for which you are eligible. Make sure to also note the Selection Criteria for the awards on your list.

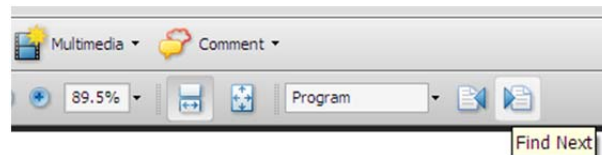
**Pay close attention to the “Eligible Program” and the “Level” columns.** Many student awards are open only to students enrolled in a specific program and/or a specific level of a specific program.

If the “Eligible Program” column indicates “Any Program”, you can apply for the student award IF you are in the year shown in the “Level” column.

4. You can also do a search of the Student Awards Guide:
  1. Type in the key word(s) you want to use in your search in the “Find” box located typically on the right side of the toolbar.



2. Press Enter
3. Use the “Find Next” button to see if there is more than one result for your search. You will need to click on “Find Next” to see each result.



### Search Word Suggestions

Make sure to search by:

- The name of your program
- “Any program”

If you belong to an Education Equity group, do an additional search by the name of the Equity group:

Aboriginal    Female    Women    Visible Minority    Disability

## How do I fill in the General Application?

Make a list of all the student awards for which you are eligible to apply, and on that list make a note of the selection criteria for each award.

Double check the program and year eligibility criteria to make sure you are eligible to apply for the award.

Once you have made your list, download a copy of the SIAST Apprenticeship Student Awards 2011-2012 General Application. The General Application is available at [www.gosiastr.com/scholarships](http://www.gosiastr.com/scholarships).

From here on in, it's very easy!

1. Tick the box next to each of the awards for which you are applying.
2. Fill in **all** the information in the Personal Information Section.
3. Attach a copy of your transcript or download an unofficial transcript from your mySIAST account and attach it. If you are in-course provide your current average and obtain your instructor's signature on the application. There is an area on the application for the signature of your instructor.
4. Sign the Student Declaration
5. Read the Selection Criteria for each award for which you are applying. Fill in the correct section of the General Application as shown on the application.

### Tips

- Carefully review the eligibility criteria for the student awards at your campus and for your program. **If you meet the eligibility criteria – apply for the award!**
- If you don't meet the eligibility criteria for an award – don't apply for it or your application may not be considered or could be disqualified
- Carefully review the selection criteria for the student awards you have ticked on the General Application, and fill out the sections or include the attachments mentioned in the selection criteria.
- Provide **all** the information requested in the Personal Information Section.
- If you are applying for an award designated to Education Equity students, be sure to tick off the correct box in Education Equity section.
- Make an appointment with the Donor and Alumni Relations Coordinator at your campus if you have any questions about eligibility and selection criteria for student awards in which you are interested.

**Make sure your application is complete and submitted by the deadline.**
